

AMENDMENT TO BUILDING AND USE RESTRICTIONS

ALPINE MEADOWS SUBDIVISION

Deschutes County, Oregon

Oakley, husband and wife, being the sole persons having an interest in that portion of Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, which has been platted and filed as "Alpine Meadows Subdivision" in Deschutes County, Oregon, do hereby amend the Building and Use Restrictions filed for said subdivision and recorded March 20, 1972 in Volume 183, page 205, Deed Records of Deschutes County, as follows:

Paragraph 9)a of said restrictions presently provides for certain restrictions on access for Blocks 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 9 which Blocks were renumbered upon the filing of the final plat and should now read and are hereby amended to read Blocks 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10.

Paragraph 9)b of said Building and Use Restrictions permitted two driveways in certain blocks of said subdivision which blocks were also renumbered upon the filing of the final plat and the proper block numbers should be and hereby are amended to read Blocks 3, 9 and 11.

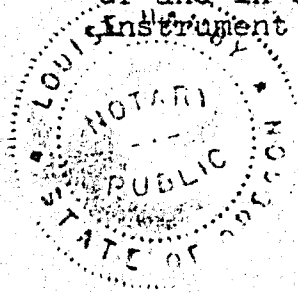
