The Grantor Central Oregon Irrigation District of Deschutes County, Oregon for and in consideration

of one and no/100ths (\$1.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, conveys and warrants to PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns, an easement or right-of-way for an electric transmission and distributing line of one or more wires and all necessary or desirable appurtenances (including telephone and telegraph wires, towers, poles, drops, guys and other supports and including the right to place all said lines in underground conduits) at or near the location and along the general course now located and staked out by the Grantee over, across and upon the following described premises, located in Deschutes County, Oregon to-wit:

The canal right-of-way of the grantor as said right-of-way is now located and used over and across the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 22; the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 27; and the North Half ( $N\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 28; all in Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M.

In the event the grantor shall reconstruct, enlarge, repair, or perform other work on its said canal, that will necessitate changes in the location of the Grantee's poles or other structures on said right-of-way, the Grantee will, upon receipt of notice from the Grantor make such changes as may be required at its own cost and expense.

Together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the grantor for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, striking new wires on, maintaining and removing said lines and appurtenances, and exercising other rights hereby granted.

In the event the grantor shall reconstruct, enlarge, repair, or perform other work on its said canal that will necessitate changes in the location of the Grantee's poles or other structures on said right-of-way, the Grantee will, upon receipt of notice from the Grantor make such changes as may be required at its own cost and expense.

Together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the Grantor for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, stringing new wires on, maintaining and removing said lines and appurtenances, and exercising other rights hereby granted.

All rights hereunder shall cease when said lines have been abandoned.
