AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF PROTECTIVE COVENANTS FOR BUSINESS PARK I

Covenants for Business Park I," dated July 26, 1974 and recorded on July 26, 1974 in Book 209 of the Deed Records of Deschutes County, Oregon, at Page 10 , SUNRIVER PROPERTIES, INC., an Oregon corporation (hereinafter, "Grantor") established certain conditions, covenants, restrictions and agreements governing the property situated in Deschutes County, Cregon, more particularly described in such Declaration and referred to therein as "the Business Park."

"Whenever two or more adjoining lots or parcels within the Business Park are commonly owned or leased, such lots or parcels shall together constitute one Site for the purposes of this Declaration so long as such lots or parcels continue to be commonly owned or leased."
