BUILDING AND USP ARSTRICTIONS C. W. REEVE RESERT TRACTS BESCHUTES COUNTY, ORIGINA

- 1. Buildings must be suitable for year around use and must be placed on a permanent foundation consisting of concrete, brick, pumice, blocks, or stone masonry, excepting foundations and footings designed by registered architects supporting their designed structures. Pitch of the roof and the size and spacing of rafters and ceiling joists must be adequate to withstand heavy snow packs. Chimneys must be constructed from ground level and shall consist of pumice or concrete blocks, bricks or stone masonry, or comparable fire-resistant materials.
- 2. All buildings must be constructed in a workmanlike manner of attractive, properly finished materials in harmony with surroundings.
- 3. Every dwelling have at least two doors as a means of access.
- 4. All dwellings must be provided with samitation facilities in accordance with or better than required by the laws of the State of Oregon as to fire protection, building construction, samitation, and public health; and any Deschutes County health and samitation requirements supplemental thereto.
- 5. SENAGE DISPOSAL AND SANITARY REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS
  - The sewage disposal system shall consist of a house sewer, a septic tank and a subsurface disposal field. Under no conditions will an exterior latrine be allowed.
  - 7. Required minimum capacities of septic tanks for desallings:

Number of Bedrooms	Capacity in gailous
1	500 gai.
2	750 gal.
3	900 gal.
4	1000 gal.

For each additional bedroom add 256 gallon.

8. Location of septic tanks shall be not less than the stated distances from the following:

(a) Any source of domestic water su	mply 50 ft.
(b) Property line	10 ft.
(c) River, Stream or lake	50 ft.
(d) Occupied building line	10 ft.
(8) Water main or service line	10 ft.

- 9. Septic tanks shall be of water tight construction and either of concrete, of not less than 14 gauge iron covered inside and out with an approved protective asphalt coating, or of other sound and durable material, approved by the State Board of Health.
- 10. All subsurface disposal fields shall have a water tight distribution box with not less than two outlets.
- 11. The docation of subsurface disposal fields shall be no less than the stated distances from the following, unless variance is anchorized by County Public Health Department.

(a) Any source of domestic water supply 100 ft.
(b) River, atteam or lake 50 ft.
(c) Water mains or service lines 10 ft.
(d) Property or duelling lines 10 ft.

- 12. The depth, width and length of treaches and construction of the disposal field shall conform to state Board of Health Standards; with an exception that the depth of the trench shall not be more than 2 feet.
- 13. The construction and operation of all domestic sewage disposal systems shall next standards as high or higher than those set forth by Oregon State Board of Health regulations governing the disposal of domestic sewage and other household wastes.

## WELLS

- 14. A properly developed deep ground water public water supply is recommended for adequate safety.
  (Deep ground water is that which is cut off from danger of kabsurface or surface contamination)
- 15. All wells shall be completed with unperforated well casing that extends to a depth of not less than 18 ft. belowland surface.
- 16. All casing installed shall be of steel, in new or like new condition, being free from pits or breaks and shall meet the following minimum specifications:

17. Casing points shall be water tight, and if welded joints are used, they shall be at least as thick as the wall thickness of the casing.

have a wall thickness of at least .250 inch.

- 18. There shall be an approved impervious seal extending to a depth of not less than 18 feet below land surface, " 'ch seal shall be at least 3 inches thick surrounding the circumference of 'he casing."
- 19. As State regulations are officially adopted by the Office of the State Engineer, they shall supersede the above regulations, numbered 2 through 5, pertaining to wells.

## 20 GARBAGE DISPOSAL REGULATIONS

- 21. Garbage shall be stored in an insect and rodent proof, cleanable container.
- 22. Garbage shall be hauled at least once a week to an approved disposal area, or disposed of in a manner approved by the Tri-County Department of Health or the State Board of Health.
- Which will any dumping of any refuse in any streams or on the adjoining federal lands be permitted.
- 24. Any open fires shall conform to the State Safety Fire Code.
- 25. Without special written approval from the Deschutes County Planning Commission no buildings shall be placed closer than 15 feet from the boundaries of the lot areas.
- 26. The grounds and buildings shall be maintained in a neat manner.
- 27. The keeping or raising of domestic livestock will not be permitted on a tract of less than one acre.
- 28. Any tract restrictions which are included herein and are in addition to the laws and regulations of the County of Deschutes and State of Oregon may be removed at any time subsequent to five years from the date of the recording of the within restrictions by a majority of the property owners of this tract by filing with the Deschutes County Clerk their affidavit that they desire a specific tract restriction or restrictions revoked and the Deschutes County Clerk is hereby authorized upon receiving affidavits to this effect to strike any such restriction from the original plat restrictions so as to give public notice that said restrictions are no longer applicable.
