He building, or other structure of any kind whatsoever shall be considered an said property for use for any other purpose than a residence together with such other incidental buildings as may be and are ordinarily used in connection with a residence. This particular restriction shall not apply to lots one (1) and two (2) in Eleck seven (7) of said subdivision.
- 2. By buildings shall be erected so they will be unsightly in any way, or shall be of unsound construction.
- 3. No norious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any lct, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or may become an amengance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- 4. We domestic livestock shall be permitted on any lot.
