

RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned,

Robert E. Weigand & Lorraine Weigand, Husband & Wife

for a good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto CENTRAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., a cooperative corporation, whose postoffice address is Redmond, Oregon, and to its successors or assigns, the right to enter upon the lands of the undersigned, situated in the County of Deschutes, State of Oregon, and more particularly described as follows:

The West half (W 1/2) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) Section 22; Township 14 South, Range 13

East of the Willamette Meridian, and to construct, operate and maintain on the above-described lands and/or in or upon all streets, roads or highways abutting said lands, an electric transmission or distribution line or system, and to cut and trim trees and shrubbery to the extent necessary to keep them clear of said electric line or system and to cut down from time to time all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees that are tall enough to strike the wires in falling.

The undersigned covenants that they are the owners of the above-described lands and that the said lands are free and clear of encumbrances and liens of whatsoever character except those held by the following:
