- 1.4 USER agrees to pay applicable sewer and water general benefit fees in accordance w policies.

ISION OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICES

Services shall be supplied only through facilities constructed and installed to City Standarications and owned by City. All facilities except USER'S service connection lines shall be public right of ways or City easements. Easements shall be granted to City free and clear of neumbrances.

- 2.1 USER shall not connect to CITY'S facilities until City accepts facilities installed by writing.
- 2.2 USER shall promptly pay all charges for City sewer and water services when due. Charbe as prescribed by the appropriate schedule and may be changed from time to time.
- 2.3 No other use of CITY services or CITY facilities shall be permitted without expres consent of the CITY.

This device must pass inspection by a certified backevention inspector. USER agrees to have test cocks installed on this device as shown in pecifications. USER also agrees to comply with the annual requirement for checking the backetotection valves at USER'S expense.
