

BLACK BUTTE RANCH DECLARATION ESTABLISHING THE EIGHTH AND NINTH ADDITIONS TO THE GOLF COURSE HOMESITE SECTION, ANNEXING THEM TO THE GOLF COURSE HOMESITE SECTION AND SUBJECTING SUCH ADDITIONS TO THE MASTER DESIGN OF BLACK BUTTE RANCH

The property described in the plat recorded in Volume 10, page 29 in the record of Townplats, Deschutes County, Oregon, on October 2, 1970, and designated as the Eighth Addition to the Golf Course Homesite Section of Black Butte Ranch, and the property described in the plat recorded in Volume 10, page 30 in the record of Townplats, Deschutes County, Oregon, on October 2, 1970, and designated as the Ninth Addition to the Golf Course Homesite Section of Black Butte Ranch shall be subject to all of the terms and provisions of the Master Design, recorded on August 6, 1970, in Volume 171, page 501, Records of Deeds, Deschutes County, Oregon and the Black Butte Ranch Declaration Establishing the Golf Course Homesite Section and Subjecting it to the Master Design of Black Butte Ranch, recorded August 7, 1970, in Volume 171, page 531, Records of Deeds, Deschutes County, Oregon.

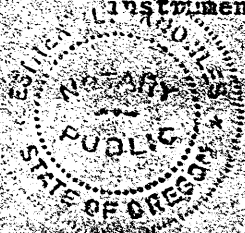
