

DECLARATION ESTABLISHING THE TWELFTH, THIRTEENTH, AND FOURTEENTH
ADDITIONS TO GOLF COURSE HOMESITES SECTION, ANNEXING THEM TO THE
GOLF COURSE HOMESITE SECTION AND SUBJECTING SUCH ADDITIONS TO THE
MASTER DESIGN OF BLACK BUTTE RANCH

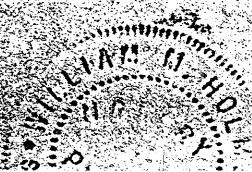
