as may have been reserved by the United States or otherwise, and also

described lands, together with the right to prospect for, mine, and remove the same.

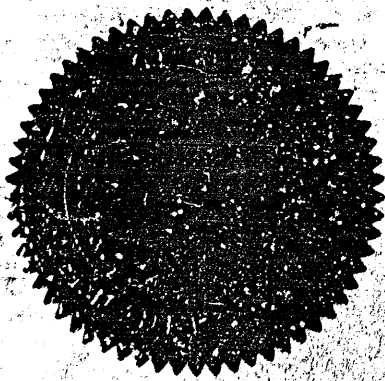
