## KING'S FOREST BUILDING AND USE RESTRICTIONS DESCRIPTES COUNTY, OREGON

The primary purpose of these restrictions are to insure the develop and maintenance of a spacious, single family residential area where like and open space insure healthful and safe living conditions, to create the perepherhood, and to insure sustained and improving residential area with values.

The undersigned, being the sole owner of the following described reproperty:

KING'S POREST, DESCHUTES COUNTY, ORECON

in order to provide for the objectives set out in the above statement of purpose, do hereby subject said property, and each division or part their to the following building and use restrictions:

- 1. There shall be only one single family residence on each parcel of land in King's Forest.
- 2. No residence shall be constructed of less than 1,400 square test of living area, exclusive of garages, porches and outbuildings. Detached garage shall be constructed of quality and appearance that will conform to the residence.
- 3. No structure of a temporary character, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuilding shall be used on any parcel at any time as a residence either temporarily or permanently.
- 4. Every building shall have a good roof.
- 5. All front yards shall be landscaped within six months after exterior is finished with no less than 20% of front yard to be in grass, the rest to be natural, or with bark chips in a professional looking manner.
- 6. There shall be no swine, horses, cattle, poultry or goats on said premises.
- 7. All plans to be reviewed by subdivider before construction starts.
- 8. No building, whether intended for use in whole or in part as a main residential structure, or for use as a garage or other outbuilding, shall be moved upon the premises.
- 9. In general, all homes will be single story, except on sites which lend themselves to de light basements. Views from all parcels will be safeguarded to the greatest possible extent. A shift of use of outdoor decks and patios will be encouraged.

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- 10.All residences, dwellings and other pulldings erected shall be placed on a solid continuous poured concrete or masonry block foundation.
- Il The use of new materials on all exterior surfaces will be required, used brick will be permissible. It is desired that a majority of the homes have their exteriors made from materials indigenous to the northwest.
- 12 The use of wood stains in lieu of paints will be encouraged.

  Bright paint exteriors other than is trim or in accent panels
  will not be permitted.
- 13. Each home will be located on each parcel so as to keep as compatible as possible with the natural surroundings and with other houses.
- 14 Sewage and waste disposal shall be installed and disposed of in accordance with state and county regulations. All waste materials, paper, trash and other carbage will be held in metal containers and not allowed to be windblown or scattered about the premises.
- 15.No parcel shall be used in whole or in part, for the storage of rubbish of any character whatsoever, nor for the storage of any property or thing that will cause such lot to appear in an any property or thing that will cause such lot to appear in an unclean or untidy condition or which will be obnoxious to the unclean or shall any substance, thing, or material be kept upon eye, nor shall any substance, thing, or material be kept upon any lot that will emit foul or obnoxious odors, or that will cause noise that will or might disturb the peace, comfort or sarenity of occupants of surrounding property. No billboards or advertising signs of any character shall be established, or advertising signs of any character shall be established, placed, permitted or maintained on any lot or improvement therefore sale. Name and address signs of occupants shall be of a design which is compatible with surrounding area.
- 16.All driveways to be paved or concrete, and there shall be no excavation on any of these parcels for gravel or cinders. Existing trees may be removed only with the permission of the subdivider.
- 17. Claude Powell Jr., his heirs and assigns hereby reserve a right of way, with right of entry upon, over, under, along, across and through the said tracts of land for the purpose of repairing, constructing, operating repairing and maintaining erecting, constructing, operating of electrical energy, and for telephone lines, and/or for laying, repairing, operating and repairing any pipeline or lines for vater, gas or sewage, and any

conduits for electric or teleptone wires, and reserving to Claude Fowell, Jr., his heirs and assigns the sole right to convey the rights hereby reserved.

18. These restrictions may be amended or modified at any time by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the then owners of the parcels in King's Forest, For this purpose the record owner of each parcel of the land described above shall be entitled to one vote.
