DECLARATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, PROTECTIVE COVENANTS AND CONDITIONS FOR

PONDEROSA PINES PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, THE DECLARATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, PROTECTIVE COVENANTS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PONDEROSA PINES PROPERTY OWNER'S, DESCHUTES COUNTY, were recorded on July 9, 1970, in VOLUME 170, page 763, Deed Records, Deschutes County Oregon, hereinafter referred to as "By-Laws, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned person is a member and owner of property subject to the "By-Laws" of the PONDEROSA PINES PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION, and is a MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS for the PON-DEROSA PINES PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned person desires that the By-Laws be amended as set forth below, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the members of the PONDEROSA PINES PROPERTY OWNER's ASSOCIATION entitled to vote have through their votes amended this instrument.

NOW, THEREFORE, the members of PONDEROSA PINES PROPERTY OWNER'S AS-SOCIATION HEREBY DECLARE THAT THE COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS be amended by deleting the language therein and to read and be revised to read as follows:

ARTICLE VII SECTION 4. Buildings must be suitable for year around use and must be placed on permanent foundations, consisting of concrete, brick, pumice blocks or stone masonry. Pitch of the roof and size and spacing and ceiling joists must be adequate to withstand heavy snow packs. Roofs must be of composit on or wood shingle, enamel metal, aluminum or tile. All buildings, fences, and improvements must be constructed in a workman like manner and kept in a condition of good repair.

ARTICLE V11 SECTION 7. Mobile homes 12' x 40' or larger may be used as a permanent installation.

ARTICLE V11 SECTION 11. No animals other than household pets or horses shall be kept on any part of said property.
