PROTECTIVE RESTRICTIONS FOR

ROMAINE VILLAGE

A SUBDIVISION IN DESCRITES COUNTY, OREGON

Larry L and Lois F. Romaine, being the sole owner of the subdivision known as Romaine Village, Deschutes County, Oregon, in order to provide for the orderly development of said subdivision, does hereby and by these presents, subject said development to the following restrictions.

- 1. No lot shall be used except for residential purposes.
- 2. He mobile home smaller than ten (10) feet by 'crty (40) feet, or comparable footage, shall be placed upon a lot and not more than one (1) mobile home shall be placed upon a lot. All mobile homes shall be kept in good condition and shall be kept painted and in repair to remain esthetically compatible with other mobile homes in the tract.
- 3. Mobile homes shall be set back from the streets a minimum of twenty-five (25) feet, Five feet (5) from any side line and fifteen (15) feet from the rear property line. Any variance must be approved by developer.
- 4. Skirting must be provided for all mobile homes withing thirty (30) days after occupying the property.
- 5. Fences and buildings including carports and storage sheds shall be constructed in a manner that will not degrade the area.
- 6. No pets shall be kept upon the property except dogs and cate and these must be kept strictly on your own property and under control at all times. No pets will be allowed to run at large.
- 7. All dwellings shall have an individual sewage disposal system in compliance with the requirements of State Sanitary Authority c. Health Authority having jurisdiction. Drain fields shall be used. No drain holes will be allowed.
- S. No explicensed cars, car bodies, or any other unsightly objects will be allowed on any lot. This is aimed to keep the lots reasonably clean and have so rubbish accumulations.
- Garbage and rubbish must be kept in covered containers and must be removed from the premises regularly.
- 10. No unnecessary tree cutting will be allowed in order to preserve the natural surroundings.
- 11. All utilities in Romeine Village are underground. Therefore, landscaping must be planned as not to interfere with the utilities.
- 12. Underground television cable is provided. Therefore, no overhead antennas will be allowed.

- 13. These restriction shall run with the land and shall be binding on the cases or tenent of any or all of said land and all paragra distring by through or under them for a period of beauty-five (25) years from the date these coverants are recorded, at which time said covenants shall be antessicially extended for successive periods of ten (10) years unless by vote of a supportity of the them owners of the lots it is agreeable to change said opvenants in whole or in part.
- invalidation of any one of these foregoing covenants, restrictions or conditions or any portion thereof by court order, judgment or decree shall in no say affect any of the other remaining pr visions hereof which shall in such case, continue to remain in full force and effect.
