A special written proxy ballot was cast to the general Membership (in mid-October of 2006, enclosed with the Annual Meeting Notification) for the purpose of amending Article IV-2, related to term limits and length of term of a Director.

A change to the By-Laws of the Association requires a Membership quorum or a Board of Director's quorum. The Board of Directors has determined that a quorum exists within the Membership, as well as within the Board, to change Article IV-2 of the By-Laws.

The original By-Laws of The Village at Skyliner Summit HOA were filed on 1/31/03 in the Deschutes County Records Number 2003-07354.

The First Amendment to the By-Laws was filed on 1/12/04 in the Deschutes County Records Number 2004-01344, and related to Articles III and Article Iv-2.

The Article IV-2 shall read as follows, taking into consideration the First Amendment related to this Article:

"The Board of Directors of the Association will be composed of five (5) Members. A Director's term shall be defined as two (2) consecutive years, beginning on January 1st after election (or an appointment in which the Member may have filled a partial term). A Director may serve more than one (1) term."

Upon approval of this Amendment, the undersigned, as President of the Association, is Directed to file this Amendment with the Deschutes County Recorder on behalf of the Association.
