## AMENDMENT TO PLAN OF SUNRISE VILLAGE

The Plan of Sunrise Village dated December 23, 1981 recorded in Book 279, Page 210, Deed Records, Deschutes County, Oregon, is hereby amended by adding a new Section 4.10 which reads as follows:

No owner or owners of any Transient Rental Use. unit within Sunrise Village shall be permitted to rent their unit to any person or persons for transient occupancy which shall be for a period of 30 days or less. A rental shall be defined as the use or possession or the right to use or possess for lodging or sleeping purposes any unit in Sunrise Village and rent shall mean the consideration charged whether or not received by the owner for the occupancy of the unit any money, goods, labor, credits, property or other consideration valued in money without any deduction. Transient use shall not include a rental of any unit for a period of in excess of 30 This restriction against consecutive calendar days. transient rental use shall not be applicable to Lot 4, Block 3, Outback Section until such time as the existing cwnership of said lot, as of the date of this amendment, has transferred.
